

2010 Girls' Tennis Advisory Minutes:

The Girls' tennis coaches would like to help the board become aware of future recommendations:

Rational why we should change our team format for both Conference play and State play for both the Boys' and Girls' tennis seasons.

During both boys and girls tennis seasons the format used to play our matches are 6 singles matches and 3 doubles matches and players can play in both singles and doubles.

Since we run our dual matches with a 6-3 format all season long, the coaches would like to have our Conference and State tournament run the same way our dual matches are run during the season. The team competition should not change with postseason tournament play. We play a 6-3 format all season long, we should continue to play a 6-3 format in tournament play.

In the past years during Conference play and State play the format used was 3 singles and 2 double teams (3-2 format). The players can only play singles or doubles, which drastically changes the way of preparing for tournament play. The whole season is played with a 6-3 format why not keep the same format we used during the regular season play.

The coaches have started the process by looking into the feasibility of playing more matches, facilities, and time restraints.
